He began his career in France, where he was the chief winemaker for his family's heritage vineyard in Champagne. He was also mentored in Burgundy at maison Chanson père et fils and in Bordeaux at château Lascombes (2nd Growth).

In 2005, Mr. Morlet moved to the United States. After a short stint at Joseph Phelps, he was appointed as winemaker for Peter Michael Winery. He inherited wines with scores in the mid-90's, and within a few years grew the brand into a world-recognized portfolio of Grand Crus and First Growths with numerous 99 and 100 point scores earned. Capturing the essence of the Terroir, he creates elegant, complex wines exhibiting seamless texture, intense aromas, and a remarkable ability to age gracefully.

After working in this role for 15 years, he is now offering his expertise as consultant winemaker to a few exclusive 'Grand Crus' aspiring wineries.

Mr. Morlet is an expert in world-class vineyard research and establishment. His extensive knowledge of French and American viticulture and enology, matched with his unparalleled drive for perfection will bring a unique advantage to your label in the competitive luxury wine market.
